

## Parks & Playgrounds Are Closed Use Of Basketball Courts Prohibited

Consistent with the NJ Governor Phil Murphy's Emergency Declaration and executive orders, all recreational facilities including parks and playgrounds were closed as of March 16, 2020. Parks and play areas will remain closed until the Governor lifts the Emergency Declaration.

To prevent gatherings and limit the spread of COVID-19, all City of Camden basketball courts are closed. The basketball rims are being removed out of precaution by the City's Department of Public Works. For public health and safety reasons, we ask the public stay at home and follow the Governor's orders.

Signs have been posted at the major points of entry to all parks and playgrounds, and this notice has been placed on the City of Camden website and City social media accounts.
