

## Closed Per Executive Order # 104

The health and safety of the Camden community is paramount. We are confident the appropriate steps to limit novel coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreaks are being taken and urge everyone to follow the recommendations of public health officials.

NJ Governor Phil Murphy's Emergency Declaration (Executive Order #104) has limited gatherings and ordered the closure of certain facilities including non-essential businesses. The purpose of the action is to limit one-to-one contact in an effort to reduce the spread of the virus. This Declaration follows the guidelines issued by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and NJ Department of Health.

All restaurants and bars must close for all eat-in service. However, restaurants and bars may stay open until 8:00 p.m. for take-out and delivery service only.

Consistent with the Governor's Declaration, the following businesses are ordered to close immediately until further notice:

- All racetracks, casinos, gyms, fitness centers, movie theatres, arts centers, concert venues, nightclubs and other entertainment centers.
- All personal-care businesses, barber shops, hair salons, spas, nail and eyelash salons, tattoo parlors and social clubs.
- All indoor retail shopping malls, amusement parks & amusement centers.
