Please note summary of Public Decorum rules below.

Rule XVII: Decorum

Any person who shall disturb the peace of the Council, make impertinent or slanderous remarks or conduct himself in a boisterous manner while addressing the Council shall be forthwith barred by the presiding officer from further audience before the Council, except that if the speaker shall submit to proper order under these rules, permission for him to continue may be granted by a majority vote of the Council.

City Council meetings shall be conducted in a courteous manner. Citizens and Council members will be allowed to state their positions in an atmosphere free of slander, threats of violence or the use of Council as a forum for politics. Sufficient warnings may be given by the Chair at any time during the remarks and, in the event that any individual shall violate the rules of decorum heretofore set forth, the Chairperson may then cut off comment or debate. At the discretion of the Chairperson, light signals may be used to display the commencement of the time for speaking and a warning light may be flashed to show that the appropriate time has passed. A red light will signal that there is no longer time.

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE STREET VACATION FOR SPECTRUM CAPITAL CAMDEN, LLC FOR BLOCK 110, LOTS 11, 16, 49, 51 (QUALIFIER) B-01 AND 67, 1107 PENN STREET, NS AD WILSON 74 E OF 11TH STREET, 1182 LINDEN STREET, 112-1156 LINDEN STREET AND SS LINDEN 418 E. 11TH STREET AS MORE PARTICULARLY SET FORTH IN THE ATTACHED METES AND BOUNDS DESCRIPTIONS PURSUANT TO AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH N.J.S.A. 40:67-1, ET SEQ.

WHEREAS, Spectrum Capital Camden, LLC has requested a street vacation of portions of certain alleyways for the propose of constructing a hotel located at Block 110, Lots 11, 16, 49, 51, 51 (Qualifer) B-01 and 67, 1107 Penn Street, NS AD Wilson 74 E of 11th Street, 1182 Linden Street, 1112-1156 Linden Street and SS Linden 418 E. 11th Street, Camden, NJ as more particularly set forth in the metes and bounds descriptions attached hereto as Exhibit "A;" and

WHEREAS, no reservations or objections have been made; and

WHEREAS, the matter has been referred to the City Engineer, who has recommended that the City proceed with the vacation; and

WHEREAS, it appears to the City that the public will not be adversely affected by the vacating of the public right in these areas; and

WHEREAS, the City is desirous of retaining a utility easement over the portions being vacated; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Camden that:

SECTION 1. The rights of the public and the City of Camden and to the Plan of Survey, proposed Block 110 and Lots 11, 16, 49, 51, 51 (qualifier) B-01 and 67 as more particularly set forth in the attached metes and bounds descriptions are hereby extinguished and vacated, with the exception of the retention of a maintenance and utility easement. The vacation shall comply with all conditions of the vacation approval that the applicant is responsible for as per the City Engineer. Please see Exhibit "A" for the detailed legal description of the Block and Lots, being vacated.

SECTION 2. All municipal public utilities and cable television lines and facilities, if any, existing in, on or under the vacated streets as described in the legal descriptions shall remain the property of the City of Camden, applicable public utility or cable television company. The City of Camden expressly reserves an easement in, on or under those portions of the streets to be vacated. The party or parties, who become owners of the vacated streets under this ordinance, and their successors in title, shall not have the right to close, remove, relocate, erect any structure upon, or block access to any municipal or public utility or cable television lines or facilities existing in, on or under the vacated streets. They shall have the right to contract with the City of Camden or applicable public utility or cable television company to close, remove, relocate, detour or operate and maintain any such municipal public utility or cable television company lines and facilities. The party or parties who become owners of the vacated streets must maintain fire access to the vacated streets at all times.

SECTION 3. The street vacations are subject to the rights of the City of Camden and of public utilities to enter the vacated streets in a reasonable manner for the purpose of inspecting, maintaining, repairing, replacing, closing or removing any municipal public utility or cable television lines and/or facilities remaining in, on or under the vacated streets, unless the City of Camden or public utility or cable television company waives such right by contract or agreement under Section 2 above.

SECTION 4. The Municipal Clerk shall have this ordinance published once, not less than (10) days instead of one (1) week prior to the second reading.

SECTION 5. Any portion of this ordinance not herein amended and supplemented shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 6. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed as to such inconsistencies only.

SECTION 7. This ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after final passage and publication as provided by law.

SECTION 8. The Municipal Clerk shall, within sixty (60) days after this ordinance becomes effective, file a certified copy of this ordinance, together with a copy of the proof of publication, in the Office of the Camden County Clerk/Register of Deeds with instructions that the certified copy of this ordinance be recorded and properly indexed in the street vacation book.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:27BBB-23 and N.J.S.A. 40:69A-41, a true copy of this Ordinance shall be forwarded to the Mayor, who shall have ten (10) days from the receipt thereof to approve or veto this ordinance. Additionally, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:27BBB-23, a true copy of this ordinance shall be forwarded to the State Commissioner of Community Affairs, who shall have ten (10) days from the receipt thereof to veto this ordinance, and the action by the Commissioner regarding this ordinance shall supersede any action by the Mayor on the same ordinance. All notices of approval and/or veto shall be filed in the Office of the Municipal Clerk.

WHEREAS, the Applicant, Spectrum Capital Camden, LLC (the "Applicant"), has submitted a street vacation application requesting the vacation of portions of certain alleyways located at Block 110 and Lots 11, 16, 49, 51, 51 (qualifer) B-01 and 67 on the tax maps of the City of Camden, and

WHEREAS, on February 13, 2020, the Planning Board of the City of Carnden held a public hearing in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40:55D-1 et. seq., the Municipal Land Use Law N.J.S.A. 10:4-6 et. seq., and the Open Public Meeting Act to consider said application; and

WHEREAS, testimony was provided that the Applicant is the owner of various lots bounded by North 11th Street, Linden Street and Penn Street. Testimony was provided that the street vacations are proposed in connection with the previously approved hotel that is to be constructed on the subject lots. Elnardo J. Webster, Esquire, counsel for the Applicant advised that the Applicant is not seeking to vacate a sewer line that runs across the Property. Mr. Webster further advised that there are no utilities within the alleys to be vacated. In addition, the Applicant agreed that as conditions of approval that the Applicant would seek and obtain approval from the City Engineer, that the Applicant will file a street vacation plan and description with the Camden County Clerk's office and provide a stamped copy to the City of Camden, and Applicant will also record any and all easements and submit same prior to signing of the plans; and

WHEREAS, it was the finding of the Planning Board and the Planning Board professional staff that appropriate testimony had been provided to support the requested vacation of alleyways on the Property. It was noted on the record that there were no objections by the Planning Board

professionals as it related to the requested street vacations provided the Applicant complied with the City of Camden Engineer's review letters and comply with conditions set forth above; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Board opened the hearing to the public and no public comment was offered in response to the Application.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Camden Planning Board that the street vacation application as filed by the Applicant, Spectrum Capital Camden, LLC, is herewith recommended to the City of Camden governing body for approval conditioned upon the compliance with any City of Camden Engineer review letter, and subject to the conditions listed above.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:27BBB-6 a true copy of this Resolution shall be forwarded to the Mayor who shall have ten (10) days from receipt thereof to approve or veto this Resolution. Notice of approval or veto shall be filed with the Office of the Municipal Clerk.

- 1. A copy of the metes and bounds description for the proposed right-of-way vacation was not provided with submittal. Please submit for review.
- 2. Plan does not clearly identify the area(s) for proposed vacation. Please revise plan as needed to clearly identify the area(s) to be vacated.
- 3. Applicant shall identify any existing utilities (i.e., size, type, material, etc.) within the requested limits of the proposed vacation. If applicable the applicant shall prepare a alley/street vacation plan indicating said utility information prior to any approval.
- 4. If applicable, the Applicant shall show on the alley/street vacation plan the size of all proposed easements for all existing utilities to remain.
- If granted, the Applicant shall at no cost to the City of Camden file the Street Vacation plan and description at the Camden County Clerk's Office and provide proof and copy of the same to the City of Camden.
- 6. If granted, any/all proposed easements shall be recorded by the Applicant and time and date stamp shall be submitted prior to signing of the plans.
- 7. Applicant shall be solely responsible for abandonment, and/or relocation of City utilities (i.e., water, sewer, etc.) impacted by the proposed street vacation at no cost to the City of Camden.



BARGAIN AND SALE DEED WITH COVENANTS AGAINST GRANTOR'S ACTS

This Deed is made as of the __day of April____, 2017, BETWEEN

and

SPECTRUM CAPITAL CAMDEN LLC, whose address is 200 Roosevelt Place, Suite E, Palisades Park, NJ 07650, referred to as the "Grantee".

The words "Grantor" and "Grantee" shall mean all Grantors and all Grantees listed above.

Transfer of Ownership. The Grantor grants and conveys (transfers ownership of) the property (bereinafter the "Property") described below as is to the Grantee. This transfer is made for the sum of \$515,000.00 (Five Hundred Fifteen Thousand and 00/100 Dollars). The Grantor acknowledges receipt of this money.








ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CALENDAR YEAR 2021 TO EXCEED THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET COST OF LIVING AND TO ESTABLISH A CAP BANK

WHEREAS, the Local Government Cap Law, N.J.S. 40A: 4-45.14 et seq., provides that in the preparation of its annual budget, a municipality shall limit any increase in said budget up to 1.0% unless authorized by ordinance to increase it to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, subject to certain exceptions; and,

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.15a provides that a municipality may, when authorized by ordinance, appropriate the difference between the amount of its actual final appropriation and the 3.5% percentage rate as an exception to its final appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Camden in the County of Camden finds it advisable and necessary to increase its CY 2021 budget by up to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Camden hereby determines that a 3.5% increase in the budget for said year, amounting to \$ 3,649,903.88 in excess of the increase in final appropriations otherwise permitted by the Local Government Cap Law, is advisable and necessary; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Camden hereby determines that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Camden, in the County of Camden, a majority of the full authorized membership of this governing body affirmatively concurring, that, in the CY 2021 budget year, the final appropriations of the City of Camden shall, in accordance with this ordinance and N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14, be increased by 3.5 %, amounting to \$ 3,649,903.88, and that the CY 2021 municipal budget for the City of Camden be approved and adopted in accordance with this ordinance; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that any that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance as introduced be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services within 5 days of introduction; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance upon adoption, with the recorded vote included thereon, be filed with said Director within 5 days after such adoption.BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that a certified copy of this ordinance upon adoption, with the recorded vote included thereon, be filed with said Director within 5 days after such adoption.

SECTION 1. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed as to such inconsistency only.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after its final passage and publication as provided by law.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this ordinance is declared invalid, such invalidity shall not effect the other provisions of this ordinance. Furthermore, the other provisions of this ordinance are deemed to be severable and remain in full force and effect.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:27BBB-23 and N.J.S.A. 40:69A-41, a true copy of this Ordinance shall be forwarded to the Mayor, who shall have ten (10) days from the receipt thereof to approve or veto this Ordinance.
