Please note summary of Public Decorum rules below.

Rule XVII: Decorum

Any person who shall disturb the peace of the Council, make impertinent or slanderous remarks or conduct himself in a boisterous manner while addressing the Council shall be forthwith barred by the presiding officer from further audience before the Council, except that if the speaker shall submit to proper order under these rules, permission for him to continue may be granted by a majority vote of the Council.

City Council meetings shall be conducted in a courteous manner. Citizens and Council members will be allowed to state their positions in an atmosphere free of slander, threats of violence or the use of Council as a forum for politics. Sufficient warnings may be given by the Chair at any time during the remarks and, in the event that any individual shall violate the rules of decorum heretofore set forth, the Chairperson may then cut off comment or debate. At the discretion of the Chairperson, light signals may be used to display the commencement of the time for speaking and a warning light may be flashed to show that the appropriate time has passed. A red light will signal that there is no longer time.

WHEREAS, Felisha Reyes-Morton resigned as Councilwoman for the Fourth Ward for the City of Camden, New Jersey, effective on July 14, 2023; and

WHEREAS, on July --, 2023, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:16-11, the Municipal Clerk received three (3) nominees from the Camden City Democratic Committee for consideration by the City Council of the City of Camden, to fill the vacancy in the Office of Councilperson for the Fourth Ward created by the resignation of Former Councilwoman Felisha Reyes-Morton, and these nominees include: ------; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:16-11, the City Council of the City of Camden, is authorized to appoint one of the nominees as the successor to fill the vacancy created by the resignation of Former Councilwoman Felisha Reyes-Morton; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Camden, that it hereby appoints to serve as Councilperson for the Fourth Ward for the City of Camden to fill the vacancy created by the resignation of Former Councilwoman Felisha Reyes-Morton for the unexpired term of Former Councilman Felisha Reyes-Morton.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:27BBB-23, a true copy of this Resolution shall be forwarded to the State Commissioner of Community Affairs, who shall have ten (10) days from the receipt thereof to veto this Resolution. All notices of veto shall be filed in the Office of the Municipal Clerk.
