Please be advised that the City of Camden has contracted with a new solid waste vender and a new recycling vender. The City’s new solid waste vender is **Suburban Disposal (54 Montesano Rd, Fairfield, NJ 07004)**. The City’s new recycling vender is **Seaside Waste Services Inc. (253 N White Horse Pike, Hammonton, NJ 08037)**. The City of Camden would like to remind residents and business owners that both **solid waste and recycling are picked up once per week citywide.**

Normal household trash must be placed in trash receptacles (cans) or heavy-duty bags that are securely tied. Trash and recycling containers must be placed in your designated areas the evening prior to pick up. Failure to comply with city code for proper disposal is a violation of **MC 620-81** and **MC 711-7(e)**. Violators are subject to penalties and fines.

Also, as required by the state “[Electronics Waste Management Act](#)”, electronic waste or e-waste items such as televisions, personal or portable computers, computer monitors and other electronics ***cannot be disposed with regular trash.*** For proper disposal, schedule your pick up by calling the Department of Public Works at 856-757-7132 or 856-757-7139.
