Just one item that I have for you all tonight is the Downtown Master Plan. Camden County along with the joint board, have been working on a Downtown Master Plan for probably two years. They've had significant community engagement throughout the community in Downtown, mainly, Cooper Grant. The Center City Business District, Cooper Plaza and Lanning Square. They are at the point now in their planning process of bringing the results and the outcomes to the Planning Board within the next month or two.

Just giving you a heads-up as to their progress, I personally have been involved in a number of meetings with the joint board and Cooper's Ferry, as well as smaller meetings with various groups within the community. And I think that once they come before the Planning Board for review of your consideration, I think that you'll be quite pleased with the efforts that have been made by the County along with the joint board and others in moving the Downtown Master Plan along.

Block 338, Lot 26 is an area in need of Redevelopment with the Power of Eminent Domain. (Condemnation Redevelopment Area).

DR. WILLIAMS: Thank you, Mr. Vice-Chair and members of the Board. The genesis of Item 'C' on your agenda is based on meetings and conversation with a developer who wishes to expand at the location of South 6th Street between Liberty Street and Mechanic Street. It's also bordered by way of 7th Street near 676. For the members of the Board, that was privy to a concept review by the Charter School that is building an athletic field at the corner of 7th & Kaighn. The location is probably across the street from this location.

The goal of this redevelopment study and eventual Redevelopment Plan, is to acquire property that is within the development building envelope of the area. That is scheduled to be on the docket within the next couple of months. But we want the Board's permission to be begin the process of developing a report that seeks to acquire at least one property within this investigation area.

Again, the purpose of the study is to plan for redevelopment by acquiring one or more properties within that redevelopment area. And I'm
