The City of Camden Department of Planning and Development hereby announces a proposed amendment to the Fiscal Year 2024 Fiscal Year Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program.

The proposed amendment would reprogram \$75,000 of CDBG funds to establish a set-aside for Section 108 Loan Guarantee Program closing and issuance costs, including but not limited to legal fees, underwriting, appraisal, credit subsidy, and related financing expenses required to complete a Section 108 loan transaction.

The set-aside is necessary to facilitate project implementation and ensure compliance with HUD Section 108 loan requirements.

This action is being undertaken in accordance with the City's Citizen Participation Plan and the guidelines set forth by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).
