The City of Camden Department of Planning and Development hereby announces a proposed amendment to the Fiscal Year 2020 Fiscal Year Annual Plan for the Community Development Block Grant Coronavirus (CDBG-CV) Program.

The proposed amendment will reprogram \$52,000.00 in CDBG-CV funds to support a Youth Workforce Development Program. The purpose of this activity is to provide workforce readiness training, employment preparation, and skill-building opportunities for youth impacted by the economic effects of the COVID-19 pandemic.

The proposed activity is consistent with the objectives of the CDBG-CV Program, which are intended to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the impacts of COVID-19 while benefiting low- and moderate-income individuals and communities.

This action is being undertaken in accordance with the City's Citizen Participation Plan and the guidelines set forth by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).
