The City of Camden Department of Finance – Bureau of Grants Management hereby announces a proposed amendment to the Fiscal Year 2018 and 2024 Annual Action Plans for the HOME Investment Partnership.

The proposed amendment in the amount of \$130,991.55 will reprogram funds between activities in the following manner:

- FY2018 HOME funds will be reprogrammed from the First-Time Homebuyers Program to St. Joseph's Carpenter Society for the rehabilitation of two affordable housing units.
- FY2024 HOME funds will be reprogrammed from St. Joseph's Carpenter Society for rehabilitation of two affordable housing units to the First-Time Homebuyers Program.

This amendment is being undertaken to ensure the timely expenditure of HOME funds from Fiscal Year 2018, while also replenishing the First-Time Homebuyers Program with Fiscal Year 2024 funds so that the program may continue to operate.

This action is being undertaken in accordance with the City's Citizen Participation Plan and the guidelines established by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).
