CITY OF CAMDEN DEPARTMENT FINANCE

The City of Camden Department of Finance – Bureau of Grants Management hereby announces a proposed amendment to the Fiscal Year 2020 Annual Action Plan for the Community Development Block Grant Coronavirus (CDBG-CV) Program.

The proposed amendment will reprogram \$50,000.00 in CDBG-CV funds to support a Youth Entrepreneurship and Digital Workforce Development Program. The purpose of this activity is to provide employment preparation and skill-building opportunities, including digital workforce certifications, for youth impacted by the economic effects of the COVID-19 pandemic.

The proposed activity will primarily benefit low- to moderate-income individuals and is consistent with the objectives of the CDBG-CV Program, which are intended to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the impacts of COVID-19.

This action is being undertaken in accordance with the City's Citizen Participation Plan and the guidelines set forth by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).
