

PUBLIC NOTICE
CITY OF CAMDEN DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING AND
DEVELOPMENT

The City of Camden Department of Planning and Development hereby announces a proposed amendment to the Fiscal Year 2020 Fiscal Year Annual Plan for the Community Development Block Grant Coronavirus (CDBG-CV) Program.

The City proposes to amend the scope of the previously approved CDBG-CV activity and reprogram the associated \$680,000 originally designated for the development/acquisition of a mobile health unit.

The City will no longer pursue the mobile health unit and instead will continue to fund and expand the Healthy Neighborhood Program by providing community-based health outreach activities designed to prevent, prepare for, and respond to COVID-19. The expanded activity will include COVID-19 vaccination events, health education and outreach, referrals and connections to health-care resources, and other eligible health services for residents, including individuals with underlying health conditions that may increase their vulnerability to COVID-19 and serious illness.

The amended activity may also include the provision of eligible durable medical equipment (DME) and related supplies or services when necessary to support the delivery of eligible COVID-19-related health services and address identified barriers to prevention, treatment, or access to care.

The amendment will allow the City to utilize CDBG-CV resources through a community-based approach that increases access to preventive health services and reaches residents who may be at increased risk from COVID-19. All activities and expenditures will be carried out in accordance with applicable HUD CDBG-CV requirements, including eligible activity requirements, national objective requirements, procurement requirements, and applicable federal, state, and local regulations.

This action is being undertaken in accordance with the City's Citizen Participation Plan and the guidelines set forth by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).

The Department of Finance Bureau of Grants Management will accept written comments concerning these changes. Residents can submit
